



**RESOLUTIONS OF THE SPECIAL JOINT SUPERVISORY BODY MEETING  
HELD ON FRIDAY, 22<sup>ND</sup> APRIL, 2022  
AT THE GATEWAY HOTEL, PORT MORESBY, NATIONAL CAPITAL  
DISTRICT**

In the true spirit of implementing the Bougainville Peace Agreement and maintaining peace by peaceful means, both Co-chairs of this Special JSB have agreed and accepted that dialogue at the highest levels between leaders of both Governments shall continue as lead up to the final report presented to the national leaders of the 11<sup>th</sup> National Parliament to decide and determine the political status of the Bougainville.

The Co-chairs have duly noted that technical officials of both Governments have delivered on the directives of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Joint Post Referendum Consultation Dialogue of 09<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 and the Resolutions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> JSB meeting of 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 at the APEC Haus.

Given the above, both Co-chairs are pleased to inform this Special Joint Supervisory Body that the "Era Kone Covenant" was signed on the 05<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 at Sir Manasupe Haus and endorsed by both Executive Councils.


On this note, we are pleased that the JSB has noted and accepted the JTT resolutions of 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2022 and have directed that:-

1. The Joint Legal Technical working group immediately commence discussions on drafting of the Constitutional Regulations, consistent with article 1 (V) of the "Era Kone Covenant".
2. Consistent with article 1(iii) of the Era Kone Covenant, the Joint Legal Technical Working Group to also commence the preparations of a Report to the 11<sup>th</sup> National Parliament in 2023
3. The JSB proper shall be convened at a later date (to be confirmed) to be held in Kimbe, West New Britain Province.

We, the Co-Chairs of this special JSB Meeting agree that these resolutions are the true outcomes of the meeting
